## Monday, June 22<sup>rd</sup> - Saturday, June 27<sup>th</sup> 2026




Chartres is one of the most beautiful and energetic places on earth. We will be invited to enter into the wonderful symbolism of the whole building, the stained glass windows and the labyrinth. In Chartres we will have special opening times into the crypt, in the morning before the cathedral officially opens and a labyrinthwalk just for our group.

The labyrinth is a metaphor of the life path. It is our journey through time reflecting major life themes like departures, turnings, achievements, and the mysteries and grace of being led. All together this week will be an extraordinary experience that will create lifelong memories.









Gernot Candolini (\*1959) is a labyrinth builder in Europe and former headmaster of the Montessori School in Innsbruck, Austria. Every year he leads several groups to Chartres. He is a great storyteller and guide to the cathedral of Chartres. He is the author of several books, like "Labyrinths – Walking Toward the Center (Crossroad Publishing), and "Places of Light - the Gift of Cathedrals to the World" by Gernot Candolini and Jennifer Brandon (Paraclete press). 
Day 1 MON: 6 p.m. Reception and Welcome


French Dinner
